



Keywords seminar: 'academic'

1: *Of the academy (academe Greek):*

Synonyms: scholastic, instructional, pedagogical; university scholarly, intellectual, clever, learned, educated, cultured, highbrow, pedantic,

2: not of practical relevance; of only theoretical interest.

- "the debate has been largely academic"

Synonyms: unpragmatic, abstract, vague, general; impractical, unrealistic, irrelevant, useless;



Keywords seminar: 'knowledge'

Episteme:

- **repeatable rules, codified and universal – in other words science**

Techne:

- **craft, capability – the idea that someone so endowed would be able to do something that was neither pure thought nor purely manual activity**

Phronesis:

- **social skills, emotional intelligence – something which a good manager or teacher would have**

Metis:

- **savvy, cunning, street smart – Embodied by Homer in Odysseus**



Keywords seminar: 'evidence'

- ground for belief or disbelief; data on which to base proof or to establish truth or falsehood= proof, grounds, data, demonstration, confirmation, verification, corroboration, authentication, substantiation
- (*law*) matter produced before a court of law in an attempt to prove or disprove a point in issue, such as the statements of witnesses, documents, material objects= testimony, statement, witness, declaration, submission, affirmation, deposition, avowal, attestation, averment



Keywords: 'partnership'

- a contractual relationship between two or more persons carrying on a joint business venture with a view to profit, each incurring liability for losses and the right to share in the profits
- the deed creating such a relationship
- the persons associated in such a relationship cooperation, association, alliance, sharing, union, connection, participation, cooperative
