| Voluntary action | Volunteering or mutual exchange (self-help) to improve quality of life in neighbourhoods or provide services to address unmet needs |

| Community organising | Developing the capacity, power and influence of residents to improve quality of life in a neighbourhood or change the way services are delivered |
| Social action | Mobilising to achieve political change, social justice or distribution of resources, often through direct action e.g. occupations |
| Community economic development | Engaging in neighbourhood-based forms of enterprise including management of physical assets to generate investment and income or create jobs |
| Community involvement in service delivery | Co-production of design, commissioning or delivery of services to improve outcomes for residents |
